



BAKERSFIELD PET FOOD PANTRY (BPFP)

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS STARTING AUGUST 9, 2014

You must show current valid I.D. each visit to the Pantry.

BPFP does not donate to anyone breeding, selling, flipping animals, feeding stray and/or feral animals, or illegal activities including dog fighting.

Food cannot be picked up for anyone else, only for your household.

BPFP can provide food for up to **3 pets** per household as food is available.

Food will be provided no more than **6 times** per household in a 12 month period.

You **cannot** add or replace animals while receiving assistance from the **BPFP**.

The **BPFP** is not a government assistance program, is not required to provide pet food, and is made possible solely by donations and volunteers.

Every request will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

The BPFP is pro-spay/neuter!

We will provide you with low-cost opportunities, as they are currently available by other organizations in the County. We **strongly** encourage you to fix your pets and use I.D. tags on all your pets.
